**SPECIAL MEETING**

1. Mayor Frank Budra called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.
2. Council members present were: Bruce Barnett, Bobby Hancock, Zach Lovelace, Michael Stringfield and Gary Watkins.

5. Citizen Comments: None


**REGULAR AGENDA ITEMS**

1. City Manager, Kevin Farley updated Council on the proposed contract with All American Animal control which had been presented at the previous meeting. A representative for All American was unable to attend the meeting due to prior engagements.  
  
Council discussed with staff the possibilities of other options down the road should the contract end up not working well for Pottsville. It was verified that the City could cancel at any time with the proper notice.  
  
Motion by Bobby Hancock and seconded by Michael Stringfield to accept the All American Animal Control Contract as presented.  
  
Council continued discussion.  
  
Vote: 4/1/0 - Motion carried with Michael Stringfield changing his vote to a denial.
2. Mr. Farley reminded Council that the Pottsville Youth Association item had been tabled due to a pending internal meeting that PYA would be having. There was much discussion from both Council and members of the public regarding not only the application for Fall/Winter Season usage of the park, but of possible future uses as well.  
  
Motion by Bobby Hancock and seconded by Michael Stringfield to approve the Pottsville Youth Association for an Extended Use Agreement to utilize The Ball Park facility for a fall/winter baseball/softball league.  
  
Vote: 3/2/0 - Motion carried with Zach Lovelace and Gary Watkins voting to deny.
3. Motion by Gary Watkins and seconded by Bruce Barnett to adopt a Resolution designating signers on City of Pottsville bank accounts.  
  
Vote: 5/0/0 - Motion carried.
4. Mr. Farley updated Council on the budget. Council discussed the various funding methods for City projects and the differences between the funds. Council discussed the purchase of water from Denison, the mowing contract for City spaces, and potential future budget amendments.  
  
After discussion, it was determined that the Council would have another special meeting on August 22 to review what would hopefully be the final draft of the budget.
5. Motion by Gary Watkins and seconded by Bruce Barnett to adjourn at 6:41 p.m.
